



## Call for Applications

### Newsweek Scholarship in Global Leadership and Peacebuilding for International Students

---

#### About the Award

This [scholarship](#) funding is available to international students applying for the [MSc Global Leadership and Peacebuilding](#) at King's College London, for the 2022/23 academic year (beginning in September 2022). It is available to students studying full time only.

There are **2 awards** open to international students applying for the full-time programme who will be present in London throughout the academic year. Students from developing countries are encouraged to apply.

The award is open to change-makers within their communities who are interested in any and all aspects of Global Leadership and Peacebuilding. Applicants should be clear about why studying this programme will help them enact transformative change within their societies.

Recipients will be selected based on merit and a personal statement outlining the financial impact the scholarship will have (see application details for full information and expectations).

The scholarship covers the full cost of international fees of **£24,660**; as well as the additional **£400** cost of the Leadership Weekend Workshop that is a compulsory component of the programme. Successful candidates will receive stipends to cover their living expenses in the UK.

This funding has been made possible through the generous support of Dr Dev Pragad, the CEO of Newsweek, an alumnus of King's College London.

#### How to Apply

- All applicants should complete the King's College London online application process for the MSc Global Leadership and Peacebuilding, by clicking the [Apply button on the online programme pages](#) and following all necessary steps.
- The personal statement submitted for the MSc application must include: a brief sentence stating that you have also applied for this specific award; as well as a statement of the financial impact that this scholarship will have for your future plans.

- In addition, applicants need to submit a 1-2 minute video recording of themselves to [alc@kcl.ac.uk](mailto:alc@kcl.ac.uk) . **Videos longer than 2 minutes will be deleted and not considered for applications.** That video should include the applicant explaining:
  - Why they are applying to the programme;
  - What they see as the most pressing global leadership and peacebuilding challenge that is relevant to their personal context or area of interest;
  - The change they want to make in relation to that issue; and
  - How they think the content of the MSc programme can enable them to make that change.
  
- In the email that you send the video to, **you must include in the email subject title your:** student application number; and title of the funding that you are applying for.
  
- The deadline to apply for the Newsweek Scholarship in Global Leadership and Peacebuilding is **30<sup>th</sup> June 2022, 23:59 GMT.**
