



Call for Applications

School of Global Affairs Global Leadership & Peacebuilding Postgraduate Scholarship Award

About the Award

This [scholarship](#) funding is available to all students, including those from the UK and EU, and applying for the [MSc Global Leadership and Peacebuilding](#) at King's College London, for the 2022/23 academic year (beginning in September 2022). It is available to students studying full time only.

There is **1 award** open to students applying for the full-time programme who will be present in London throughout the academic year. Students from the UK and EU are welcome to apply.

The award is open to change-makers within their communities who are interested in any and all aspects of Global Leadership and Peacebuilding in the developing world. Applicants should be clear about why studying this programme will help them enact transformative change within their societies of interest.

Recipients will be selected based on merit and the overall standard of their application (see application details for full information and expectations).

The scholarship covers the value up to **£11,040** (Home fees; or as partial funding towards international fees) for 2022/23 full-time entry for one student onto their relevant course; as well as the additional **£400** cost of the Leadership Weekend Workshop that is a compulsory component of the programme.

Please note recipients are expected to cover their own living costs throughout the programme.

How to Apply

- All applicants should complete the King's College London online application process for the MSc Global Leadership and Peacebuilding, by clicking the [Apply button on the online programme pages](#) and following all necessary steps.
- The personal statement submitted for the MSc application must include: a brief sentence stating that you have also applied for this specific award; as well as a statement of the financial impact that this scholarship will have for your future plans.

- In addition, applicants need to submit a 1–2-minute video recording of themselves to alc@kcl.ac.uk . **Videos longer than 2 minutes will be deleted and not considered for applications.** That video should include the applicant explaining:
 - Why they are applying to the programme;
 - What they see as the most pressing global leadership and peacebuilding challenge that is relevant to their personal context or area of interest;
 - The change they want to make in relation to that issue; and
 - How they think the content of the MSc programme can enable them to make that change.
- In the email that you send the video to, **you must include in the email subject title your:** student application number; and title of the funding that you are applying for.
- The deadline to apply for the School of Global Affairs Global Leadership & Peacebuilding Postgraduate Scholarship Award is **30th June 2022, 23:59 GMT.**
